A well-functioning natural environment is the basis of viable agriculture. Accordingly, and with a wide range of measures, agriculture contributes to the conservation of biological diversity in the cultivated landscape. Innovation and sustainable development are the keys to keep the balance between utilisation and conservation of our natural resources.

Besides producing food as a main task, the supply of renewable energy from arable crops becomes more and more important. Which chances does the production of renewable resources offer to agriculture, but also to rural areas and their diverse plant and animal species? HOW TO REACH THE LOCATION:

By car:

A2 from the South:

Exit 21 – Bielefeld-Zentrum, turn into Lagesche Strasse/B66 in the direction of Detmold / Lage / Leopoldshöhe, continue on B66. Turn left into Grester Strasse, continue on Dorfstrasse. Turn left into Helpuper Strasse/L967. Turn right into Ehlenbrucher Strasse/K8. Turn left into Ohrser Strasse/K19. The Kemper Farm will be on your right.

A2 from the North:

Exit 29 – Herford / Bad Salzuflen, turn into Am Zubringer/B239 in the direction of Bad Salzuflen / Detmold / Lage, continue on B239. Turn right into Sylbacher Strasse/L967, continue on Helpuper Strasse/L967. Turn left into Ehlenbrucher Strasse/K8. Turn left into Ohrser Strasse/K19. The Kemper Farm will be on your right.

By train:

Take a train to the Main Station Bielefeld. From there, take a taxi to the Kemper Farm. The distance from Bielefeld to Lage-Ohrsen is about 20 km and the ride will take approximately 30 minutes.
